

Slip Proof NZ MFRP Nosing fitting recommendations for wooden, masonry and concrete floors.

Pre Clean:

Before fitting MFRP nosing's, ensure to pre clean the underside with Soudal Surface Activator (available to purchase through Slip Proof) or acetone. This removes any contaminates and promotes a good adhesion key for the adhesive.

Fasteners:

Stainless steel screw and plug method 8-gauge screws, concrete plugs. Gorilla Fix All Turbo adhesive

Fitting instructions for concrete surface:

- 1. Predrill holes evenly along middle of top of nosing (maximum 500mm centres): including one approx. 10cm from each end
- 2. Ensure surface is clean, dry, and free of any foreign matter
- 3. Mark through the holes using a permanent marker pen on to concrete surface
- 4. Drill holes in surface to 50mm depth
- 5. Clean drillings off surface and insert plugs
- 6. Turn over each deck tread or nosing and apply a zig zag line of Gorilla Fix All Turbo along the underside
- 7. Turn the nosing over so the antislip side is uppermost and locate it back in the fitted position marks. Screw down firmly in place
- 8. Walk over the entire length of the deck tread or nosing to ensure mastic makes full contact with both surfaces
- 9. Clean up any residue mastic with acetone

Fitting instructions for wooden surfaces:

As above, with the exception of using plugs these; will not be needed.

Fitting instructions for tile and waterproof stairs:

Use extra adhesive, use of bricks or similar weights can be used on top of the nosing's till cured.
